

Foreigner to the World

Part 1:

Read Matt 25:21.

Much talked about is the concept of Christians living in the World but not of the World. Note that when Jesus was tempted by Satan, the latter offered him the kingdoms of the world.

Some people say no, Satan did not really own the kingdoms and his offer was a lie, but this is not true. Between the leaders of the two opposite sides of the spiritual realm there would not have been such an obvious lie. Satan offered the only thing he had. He knew that God (Jesus) loved every individual so much that this could be a temptation, or so he thought.

But Satan did not understand anymore how God would think, since his fall. Formerly Lucifer, the light bearer, he lost his estate in heaven and with that the ability to understand how the Kingdom of Light works. When he became rebellious and was rejected by God, he became frozen in evil, dissatisfaction, discontentment and eternal grief, hate and anger.

There was a complete separation between Satan and God on all aspects. Therefore he could never know again what the concept of peace, happiness, love and honour would be. The only thing that Satan can do is to appear anything good, mimicking, but ultimately he has only one objective, and that is to devour as much as he can for a little bit of satisfaction and peace he would like to have. He is out there to spite God by stealing the most precious thing for God, which is human souls. He has a fire burning inside of him and he hates everything reminding him of God's love.

Since the fall of mankind into sin (Gen 3), all newborns have been inclined to sin and be separated from God. No, there is nothing your parents could do to secure your salvation. There is no ritual, no work that can bring mankind back to God, except repentance in faith through Jesus Christ.

Successfully Satan lured mankind away from God and built a dream castle we call society. All kingdoms, empires, countries and governmental institutions are into each other into the world carefully constructed by Evil the past 6000 years.

All forms of today's governments pry on people's desire to conquer and rule, to subdue others. It is all about "making it out there", and worldly allies are everywhere. For any person who is lost the power of democracy is addictive. Corruption is a wonderful way to make millions quickly and to get away with it, because you control who is in charge of the justice system. Some are more corrupt than others, some hide it more. Even if a government would have little financial corruption, moral corruption is rampant.

In modern society note that all forms of entertainment is designed to take your mind off the serious stuff of life, designed as distraction, hence we need to remember this. All the world gives is about bliss through pleasure and partying. So, especially young people get a kick out of partying all the time.

The agents of Satan and demons are out there to dull down churches, and most Mainline Churches (meaning large denominational groups) are dead today, the gospel eroded to a feel good message to sooth your conscience. Church Boards are busy trying to keep the peace amongst unreasonable people, entertaining rubbish instead on focussing on the job, being entangled in dogma and limited by rules and procedures, of which none are biblical.

Nowhere does anyone talk about sin anymore, because when a preacher would, people complain that he/she judges. If a preacher needs to put people in their place, then they get upset, thinking who do you think you are? Instead they forgot God has an order and the leaders have a job to do. If that leader has been ordained by God and the message is given by the Holy Spirit according to the Word (not church dogma), the person resisting would enter rebellion against God immediately. That is how God sees it.

All church meetings and structures are often to cause confusion, subordination and making people feel they do not have access to God, miracles or gifts. This is not the way it was meant to be. Any church that limits you to operate in the Spirit is not from God. Example, in some churches they resist Spirit-filled Christians to lay hands on others because they are not part of the leadership chosen by the pastor or board. No, the Gospel and miracles are not exclusive to clergy.

God (Jesus) wants all of his kids to do the work He has done, to continue and do more. This is the message of Matt 28, Mark 16 etc.

Part 2:

What is the devil like and why does he do things the way he does? (Answers in brackets)

- Why did he entice Eve to eat the forbidden fruit in Gen 3? (Mischief, to see how far he could influence a holy union. He did not know how God would respond if they were disobedient.)
- Why did he tease Nimrod in becoming the first king? (To subdue the world under one unholy man. He wanted to unite everyone in his kingdom.)
- Why did he create giants? (To corrupt the DNA of mankind, to prevent the Messiah to be born. To corrupt the world with evil doctrine. Remember that God said that Eve's seed would destroy him and God would not defile himself being born into a trans-human or hybrid.)
- Why did he build the Tower of Babel? (To entice mankind against God. To unite all the different families into one tribe by giving them a goal to break through the spiritual barrier to enter into God's realm.)
- Why did one empire after the other come? Why not just one? Why are there so many different countries fighting and so many different religions in the world? (1. To confuse the meaning of Truth, to obscure what is right and make God's ways difficult to be recognized. 2. To let his principalities have their own battles against each other for his entertainment.)
- Why did he tempt Jesus in those ways in Luke 4? (1st temptation: He just could not leave Jesus alone, he felt the urge to tempt and provoke Him, and tried to get something out of him, anything but total rejection. 2nd. Deceit, to try and make Jesus fall into sin. If Jesus would have jumped, Satan would have caught Him. 3rd He desperately offered all that he could.)

Because Satan has lost his ability to understand anything of God, he also could not see that Jesus's horrible death would have destroyed his authority. He knows the bible much better than you or me, but he cannot understand the Spiritual side of it. Satan does not understand why Christians do what we do. He cannot understand why anyone would abstain from free sex, from wealth and luxury through force and deceit, why anyone would pray and want to live holy. So, he will continue to tempt, provoke and entice you

until you fall. The moment you fall and become lost the job is done, and he goes after the next person. For a split second he feels something like satisfaction, but that is replaced immediately by grief of what he has done.

He would do anything for a bit of satisfaction and if you want to entertain the devil you would really get yourself into a difficult situation. Therefore it is very dangerous to confront the powers of Evil directly. If you take a step into that direction you are going to have all of hell rushing to you. 1 Pet 5:8.

The only way to respond to the powers of darkness is to neutralise the situation. Look at what Jesus did with the temptation, as well as everytime the Pharisees provoking him. Jesus never went into direct confrontation with the evil forces, he neutralized the situation everytime, so that nothing could come of it. His anointing and authority was enough, He never needed to defend Himself. The owner and King of the universe does not need to explain himself to anyone, neither do his children.

When Jesus reveals himself a burst of Truth, Power and Anointing goes forth. The anointing burns like a fire to anyone not in God's Spirit, especially demons. People full of demons can even get hurt. The anointing is something that cannot be ignored and every evil force cannot touch the vessel of anointing. Therefore Jesus did not do this on earth. He continuously told people to keep quiet when they figured out who He was, because He had a job to do, to show love and die on the cross, not to engage into a war against Evil.

The most powerful response to anything evil would be little or no words and then releasing the anointing from where you are. Rather think to yourself, that you would pray for the one attacking you. Prayer can be dangerous to the enemy. If you want to affect people around you immediately then touch them with much love flowing from you. Open up the gate/portal from Heaven and release God's gifts.

Part 3:

Nobody can understand the acts of the children of God, nor our personality change after salvation. You are so different from the world that you cannot hide. If you then participate with the world in their activities you tell them two things:

1. You are ok without God, you don't have to repent.
2. If you do preach to them later, you have proven yourself to be a hypocrite.

So there is no way you can keep the peace with the world and be clean. You have to separate yourself with the world and with unholy acts and friendships.

The world around you expects you to act like a Christian. They want you to set the example, even if they are not ready to get saved, they know at least what is the standard, what is right and who can show them that every day. Even if they persecute you they are still intrigued by you.

They will fear you if you are full of the Spirit and performing miracles, or have powerful prayers answered. They fear what happens to people when you lay hands on them. The same thing happened when Moses came back from the mountain and his face shone. The ordinary people could not identify themselves with this.

The lost want to know how you would react in every situation. Note, react, not respond. You are always

being watched and discussed behind your back. Never is there a moment to let go and just fall back. Demons watch you and Satan as well, even when you are at home they may look through the window. Satan has many agents, people operating in the spiritual realm, some will check you out via astral projection.

Only evil people (with demons) will really hate Christians.

So the task for today is for you the following:

1. Stop hiding under a bush. You are the salt of the earth, the light on a stand. You need to decide if you want to go to heaven or hell, on which side you are on.
2. Keep on being different and showing how Jesus would act and respond. They expect that of you.
3. Do repent, change and improve over time.
4. Be loving. All sinners know they sin inside of them. They want to see your Godly love, even when they feel guilty like hell.
5. Be stable, have integrity and be willing to help and pray. They want to know that you are there for them. They want the security from Christians that you would be who you say you are.
6. Do not try to explain yourself to the World. It looks like you are making excuses for being weird. It creates confusion.
7. Remember that we do not fight against people, but principalities, Satan and demonic powers. Try to reach out a hand to help the person getting closer to God. You can try the big brother, big sister approach. ("Let me help you, show you".)
- 8 Do tell them about the Way out of sin, when it is time to share wisdom, hope or love.

At the end of the day we want God to say Mat 25:21.

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
